



Introducing Team Alliance Global NZ (TAG NZ) Leadership Development Team Founder Sir Joshua Burton-Chadwick (Bt.). ACN Regional Vice President, Circle of Champions Member, President's Club Member.

Born in New Zealand, Sir Joshua began his working life as a signwriting apprentice before quickly moving into his passion at the time of Professional Golf, becoming a member of the NZPGA. Following his 12 year Golf Career, Sir Joshua moved into Sales and Marketing, heading up a number of companies over a 30 year time-span.

Concurrently, for 25+ years he was also involved in the Network Marketing Profession where he was a very successful entrepreneur within two network marketing companies, developing large downlines and significant customer bases. All during these times, Sir Josh developed and was the CEO of a company that customised corporate sales training systems. He is also a published author, having written and published "Australia's Premier Golf Courses".

He believes that "true success is happiness, and that happiness is an attitude which has very little to do with anything on the outside of one's life."

His past personal goals included qualifying as an RVP4 Star by 8pm October 15th 2006, (he qualified as RVP 4 Star at 7:30am on OCT 2nd 2006!) – his current goal of SVP is set for 9pm on the 1st Feb 2011 (his birthday!)

Sir Joshua concludes: "What excites me the most - much more than being an SVP, is knowing that those with Vision, and who do the work, will be joining us as we expand into each Asian Country with this brilliant opportunity! I can't wait for that! It doesn't come much better than that!
